Richard Graham, our MP has been very involved in the Ridge and Furrow campaign, and in the last few weeks he has been successful in talks with Morrisons to get them to confirm that they now have no plans to try and re-submit a new planning application for the petrol filling station.

Richard has also been in consultation with the community as to what they would like to see here. Some suggestions include the possibility of a nursery, or a family pub with a nursery which has worked in other locations and the site is suitably large enough for something like this.

Morrisons is not selling the site, so there is no opportunity at the moment for a community buy-out. Trust Inns remains the lessee, which means dealing with them. The next stage is: 1. Seeing who might be interested in establishing a business there, 2. Hearing what residents would most value, 3. Discussing with Trust Inns their plans and interest in the site.
