

## RE. Mini roundabouts on Lobleys Drive

Dear neighbour,


We have received a number of complaints from local residents regarding speeding on Lobleys Drive and the problems this has been causing at the mini roundabout junctions.

As we're sure you will have already seen, following our work with your County Councillor Andrew Gravells, works have recently been carried out to raise the zebra crossing at the end of Lobleys Drive, near to the M5 bridge, with the hope to reduce the speed of traffic on the road. We will be carrying out further speed checks with the County Council later on in the year, in order to follow up on this work.

There does however, still seem to be a cause for concern further towards the Abbeymead Avenue end of Lobleys Drive, particularly near to the Bay Tree Road and Cox's Road junctions, as we understand that traffic is not giving way to cars trying to get out of these roads onto the mini roundabouts.

If this is something you have witnessed or have concerns about, please do contact us, as we are keen to gain as much information as possible from local residents and hear your views.
