LAURA AND GORDON SELECTED FOR ABBEYMEAD


Laura and Gordon selected to re-stand for the Conservatives in Abbeymead Ward for City Council elections in May 2020

CLEARING ON HONEYSUCKLE DRIVE

Some recent tree works have been carried out on Honeysuckle Drive and the area was left looking a mess. This situation was brought to our attention by a local resident and following enquiries made by your local Councillors, we can advise the trees were removed due to subsidence damage.

Work will continue with what is left after bird nesting season

has finished. Gordon asked for the area to be cleared of rubbish, which has been done with the exception of a traffic cone which is home to a bees nest and will again be removed later in the year.

We will make sure that the area is brought back to a presentable standard as soon as is practically possible and we will keep on the case.

FLY TIPPING

Some fly tipping has been reported to us in the Abbeymead area, which Gordon and Laura have helped to get removed. If you see any cases of fly tipping then please in the first instance report it

Should it persist, do contact Laura or Gordon. If it is on public land we can organise the council to come and remove it. Fly tipping is a blight on the area and we don't want it in Abbeymead.
